ICMR-RMRCGKP is newest one of the 26 Institutes of the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), under Department of Health Research (DHR), Ministry of Health & Family Welfare of Government of India. Since, health indicators of Northeast region of Uttar Pradesh are prominently poor in comparison to average health indicators of Uttar Pradesh and much lower than all India figures. ICMR-RMRCGKP from its inception striving to reduce the total burden of disease and to promote health and wellbeing of the population through research and collaboration.

**MAHAYOGI GORAKHNATH UNIVERSITY GORAKHPUR, INDIA**, whose address is Mahayogi Gorakhnath University Gorakhpur, Arogyadham, Balapar Road, Sonbarsa, Gorakhpur-273007, Uttar Pradesh India (hereinafter referred to as "MGUGKP "). After the inception, this University is continuing as the apex referral University of the Purvanchal with several facilities with aim for reviving and re-establishing the Indian knowledge traditions in modern format and to develop a multi-disciplinary centre of excellence equipped with ultra-modern state of the art facilities, where our youth can have access to a balanced comprehensive holistic knowledge of various streams of Medical & Physical Sciences. Technology and Humanities.

**Mahayogi Gorakhnath University Gorakhpur, India and ICMR-RMRC Gorakhpur**, hereinafter collectively referred to as 'the Parties' and individually as 'the Party';

2. Desiring to establish collaborative relations between the Parties in order to promote Research and Innovation and to co-operate toward the promotion of higher education in a mutually beneficial association in general, and therefore, to develop academic and socio-

cultural exchange in education, research and other areas in particular; Health & Biomedical Research.

Have reached the following understanding:

3. The Parties shall encourage co-operation in any discipline and programme offered at either Institution as well as in further areas of cooperation, which are felt to promote the above-mentioned goals. However, any specific bilateral programme shall be subject to mutual consent, availability of funds and the approval of the Parties. Such programmes may include:

a) Explore possibilities for faculty exchanges for higher degrees, research, lectures, trainings and discussions that mutually benefit both institutions;

b) Explore the feasibility of student/researchers exchanges and study capacity building programmes;

c) Seek support for projects determined to be mutually beneficial to both institutions;

d) Explore co-operation between faculty members of Parties for the supervision of graduate/postgraduate/PhD theses and dissertations;

e) Consider organization of joint courses, training programs, workshops, conferences, seminars, and webinars;

f) Encourage co-operation between faculty members Researchers/Scientists in both in research & publications in both national and international journals;

g) Support internships and sabbaticals;

h) Consider other co-operation of mutual interest in discussion with each partner.

4. The terms of mutual assistance and co-operation shall be agreed upon in writing by the competent authority of the Parties/ head of institution prior to the initiation of any particular programme or activity. Any disagreement between the Parties with respect to any of the





provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) or the terms of mutual assistance and cooperation shall be settled through mutual consultation or negotiation.

5. Particular activities under this MoU shall be implemented subject to the terms and conditions of a separate proposal mutually agreed by both the Parties.

6. The Parties and/or their respective faculties/departments concerned for a particular activity shall decide, through consultation, the specific areas and details of co-operation within the framework of the Agreement and shall consult from time to time at the request of either Party for the purpose of reviewing and evaluating the operation of the Agreement.

7. The financial agreements involved in the implementation of this MoU shall be settled through consultation between the competent authorities of the Parties in respect of each programme of co-operation.

8. This MoU shall remain in force for a period of 5 years from the date of its signature and seal (unless expressly renewed) and may be terminated by either side by giving at least a three months advance Notice to that effect in writing. However, notwithstanding the Notice of the intent to terminate the MoU, all rights, obligations and corresponding duties flowing and subsisting therein shall be respected and mandated till the finalization and accomplishment thereof.

9. This MoU may be amended or supplemented by exchange of formal letters between the two institutions. Each amendment and/or supplement will be appended as an annex to this MoU from time to time.

10. This MoU, its intent, subsequent Agreements in pursuance of this understanding, shall be subject to the laws and policies in force in the country/state.

11. Signed at Gorakhpur on this twenty ninth day of September, 2022, in two originals in the English language, one for each Party.




